Will I be dancing for two hours?

No, there will be organized dancing for about a half hour, followed by a half hour intermission break where the kids will sit down and watch some entertainment by staff as well as the drawing for our raffles and the results of the pumpkin contests. There will be another half hour organized line dancing session to wrap up the night. You can take a break whenever needed. Food and drinks will be available throughout the night for you to purchase. There are also four water fountains within the Cafetorium if you need a quick drink while you dance.

Will I have to dance with a boy or girl?

No! All of the dances will be line dancing, led by our DJ. Also, many of our own teachers will be dancing too!

What if I don't know the line dances?

Our DJ and Mrs. Polsz will be leading the dances. If you arrive before the official dancing starts at 6:30 pm they will be teaching some of the dances before the songs are actually played. And the dances you are learning in your Music and Physical Education classes will also be played.

What if I forgot to send in my donation?

Donations will be accepted the night of the event. If you still haven't sent out your packet to family or friends, you can still do so. Donations will be accepted even after the event.

Do I have to be at the dance-a-thon to win any of the raffles or to make a donation?
